Nandini Chami is Deputy Director at IT for Change. Her work focuses on research and advocacy at the intersections of digital policy, development justice and gender equality. She is part of the core team working on policy advocacy for data justice, inclusive digital trade, and gender perspectives in the debate on ICTs as means of implementation in the SDGs. She also provides strategic support to IT for Change's field centre *Prakriye* in its training programmes for women's rights groups on adopting digital tools in their field practice, and critical 'education for empowerment' for <u>rural adolescent girls</u>. She has a Masters in Urban and Rural Community Development from the Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai.
